Hello Bill,

I finished the treatment work at your property yesterday. Friday of last week didn't work out for hemlock treatments as we had unexpected rain forecast for the afternoon. So I came back up yesterday. The Stiltgrass area has been treated and steel (pink) flags strung around the perimeter. I also treated 46 hemlock trees in total. You'll see some pink flagging on trees on the south boundary, or where it appeared the boundary was approximated. I did not treat trees south of this boundary as it appears to be on Pocono Lake Preserve lands. Otherwise, all your hemlocks greater than 6" that appeared healthy enough to benefit from the treatment were tagged with aluminum number tags and treated. Any tree with a tag was treated. Also treated larger hemlocks within 15 feet of the boat dock trail and around the stored boats as well. I will send my report to PLP management (John Hickey) detailing each tree treated along with the information in this email. Total cost for hemlock treatments came out at \$2,100, plus \$50 for the Stiltgrass treatment, plus \$50 for your portion of the PLP hemlock treatment report. So \$2,200 in total. Hemlock trees should be good for no new treatment until at least Year 2027. Thanks again Bill!

The mapping program I use, which collects information from county parcel ownership data, shows that lots 50 and 51 are both owned by PLP. I cross checked that this morning with the Monroe County GIS data on their website, and the same thing shows up. I'd be glad to spray more hemlocks on PLP ownership near you, but would want to have their blessing first. Thanks Bill.

I just spoke with John Hickey regarding the property confusion. PLP ownership shows you having Lot 51 as well as 52, despite what the county gis data says. So if it's ok with you, we'll plan on treating the hemlocks on lot 51 in October of this year. My apology for not getting them this spring, but I wanted to be sure of ownerships before treatment.
